INTERVIEW WITH HUGHAND JOHN.

The CTTANCLERS are not just another group, the STRANGLERS are an uncorrectable experience. The STRANGLERS play long, hard, complex and shoulded. The promes are very basic and hard hitting, yet still with chouch thought and imagination to make them stand out from most of the other to called 'new wave'material. Since their conception, shout a year and a half ago as the Guilford CTRANGLERS Hugh Cornwell(quiter), Jean Bucnell(bass) have Greenfield(keyboards) and Jet Slack(druan) have gone from strefith to strength. Summer 76 saw the STRANGLERS play successfull support dates at the Roundhouse and Hammeromith Edeen with fatti Spith, and it was not long after this that they sharted moving up form the publiscene' (Red Tow etc) to concert hall status (Parquee, Roundhouse, Rainhow). Their hard work was rewarded with a recording contract from UnitedArtists in December, and they have subsequently recorded a single, titled 'Cet A Grip Of Yourself'and released on the 28th Jan, and an album.

Although things are looking rosy for the STRANGLERS now, things have not always gone smoothly. They played 184 gigs last year, and many of them were by no means prestigious such as a Young Conservatives dance they played in Purley where 780 people walked out.



- 9. Did you find it hard going on the gig circut last year?
- There was a narticularily had riot at Bangor, when six big ruchy players started causing trouble. However they comped out from having a go at us and rioped up the van instead. I also remember on unpleasant gig in the Erst and where they threw sharpened 10m pieces at us.
- H. The strangest one of all was Dincwalls, the supposedly hip nitempot; where they received 57 letters of conclaint about our language, style etc after we played there.
- J. Aylesbury was supposed to be the centre of the scene, and Jet the drummer got a bottle on his head!
- S. So all in all you were really having a hard time.
- H. Oh terrible, it was too straight. They wanted long guitar rolos which they weren't getting so people were walking out.
- S. Surely this was very worrying for you?
- J. Not really, we never bothered about it. 'e knew it was going to take time, it always does when you're doing something new.
- 5. Who does the songwriting in the group?
- H. Someone gets an idea and we all work on it. We have a marxist principle about our songwriting.
- S. Do you have any particular influences on your songwritin ?

- H. Music is what you make of it. An artist reflects the enveiroment he's in, if he 's committed enough he may even want to change it.
- S. Change what?
- J. You name it, lete walk down the street and we'll see a few things. The most obvious thing is to fight the consmiracy to bring everybody down to the common denominator. There seems to be a vested interest in bringing 'thinkers' down to the level of morons.
- S. You intend to try and improve things?
- J. Whats the point in making pretty little roises, you might as well use a vibrator. We were all told that rock was supposed to make you think about things, but it hasn't lately, it's just to titillate now!
- 5. What influences the STRAMGLERS musically, your sound isn't exactly conventional is it?
- H. By mum and dad, no seriously though it's good to listen to everything. If you don't like somebhing you know why. By influence on my quitar playing is my limitations. I can only do certain things so it causes me to have a certain style. Hendrix was great he made it sound like it was talking. When I hear an Lp I may not like the whole thing, but sometimes there are certain aspects I like.
- J. I hate Steely Dan, but on a couple of albums there are some really good quitar pieces.
- S. How do the STRANGLERS see their future. How will they cope with success?
- H. The future , see as being tomorow and the day after. The future doesn't exist, because when you reach the day its present. We rebuilding up a following throughout the country and I can see it grow and grow.

STRANGLED also sees a bright future for the GTRANGLERS. Hopefully a lot more meanle will get to hear the STRANGLERS through their records and live gigs this year because music of this calibere deserves the widest possible audience!
